How to clear your cache (IOS/Safari)

If you're having logging in issues with the Itsallauto eWOF system, clearing your cache might resolve them.

This guide will walk you through on how to do this on an IOS/Safari device.

01 Access your iPhone settings

You will need to be on your home screen, find the Settings icon and then open it.





Now you need to find Safari in the settings page. You can do this either by scrolling down until you find it, or by using the search bar. In this example, we will search for it.

03 Searching for Safari

When you type Safari into the search bar, these results should pop up. You will want to select the one that says Safari, and has an icon of a blue compass.



04 Safari settings page

Doing that should take you to the page for Safari settings. Scroll down all the way to the bottom of the page to find the "Advanced" option.





Select "Advanced". This should take you to the page for the advanced settings.

09 Press the red minus button

Locate where itsallauto.com is in the list, and press the red minus button.



10 Press the "Delete" button

It should now give you the option to delete the website data for itsallauto.com , press the "Delete" button.





You should now see that itsallauto.com is no longer in the list, which means that you have successfully cleared the cache for itsallauto . Once that has been confirmed, press "Done" near the top right of the screen.
